

ABOUT COOKIES ON OUR WEBSITE

Axess Logistics* (referred to in this policy as “we”) uses cookies on the website. In short, we use cookies for the following purposes

- [For analysis and ongoing improvements to the website – if you’ve given your consent](#)
- [To show you relevant marketing from us on other websites and platforms – if you’ve given your consent](#)
- [So you can use our portal](#)
- [For the website’s functionality and to remember your choices](#)

You can find more detailed information about our use of cookies in the website’s cookie banner. Click “Show details” for instance to see the names of the cookies we use, which services they belong to, and how long each cookie is used for. You can always find this information again by clicking “cookie settings” in the bottom-left corner of our website.

What are cookies?

By “cookies”, we mean all cookies, pixels and similar tracking technologies that provide us with information about your device and store information on your device. Your personal data

When you use cookies on the website, we collect certain information that constitutes personal data. To protect your privacy, we have put measures in place to help ensure you are not identified when you use our website. For example, your IP address is encrypted, which in practice makes it almost impossible for us to track who you are. When we process information that can be linked to you directly or indirectly, we explain this in our [Integrity Policy](#).

Third-party services and third-party cookies

We mainly use standard “HTTP-cookies”, but we also use more advanced pixel cookies and third-party cookies from various marketing service providers. Google may use the collected information for its own purposes, but our other providers do not use the information for their own purposes and act solely in accordance with our instructions. Where possible, we have included links below and in our cookie banner to further details on how third parties use cookies.

Cookies we use with your consent

STATISTICS AND ANALYSIS – To analyse and further develop the website

We use both session and persistent cookies from Google, so we can **analyse how the website is used** and **improve it**.

When you use cookies on the website, we receive information about your IP address in encrypted form as well as information from your device during your visit (e.g. how many people visit different pages on the website, how long visitors stay on the website, which parts of our website are used, and which device is used). In addition, information that Google already holds about you is also used.

MARKETING – So we can show you relevant marketing

We use cookies to show you relevant marketing when you visit other websites and platforms, and to measure how effective our marketing is. We do this using Google's marketing services.

These tools mean that you can be shown search results and banner adverts from us, based on analysis of how you've used our website, as well as other information our providers hold about you (so-called "profiling").

If you block/delete these cookies, the marketing you see will be less relevant.

Your consent is voluntary

The cookies we use for these purposes aren't strictly necessary for the website to operate, so we need your consent to use cookies when you visit the site. That's why we only use this type of cookie if you first choose to give your consent.

If you block cookies, we receive less data to monitor how the website is used, and we have fewer opportunities to improve it. If you block this type of cookie, the next time you use our website you'll be asked again whether you want to accept them.

Essential cookies

We use cookies that are necessary for the website and portal to work properly, and to remember your choices. Without this type of cookie, you can't use all parts of our website. If you choose to block this type of cookie, it may mean that the website doesn't work as well as it should.

STRICTLY NECESSARY – So you can use our portal

To check whether you're signed in and to keep track of your session, we use temporary cookies. These cookies are deleted when you close your web browser.

We also use a cookie to make sure that anything you add to your basket stays there until you return to the basket during your visit.

These cookies are essential for the portal to work properly, so no consent is required to use them.

STRICTLY NECESSARY – For the website's functionality and to remember your choices

We use temporary cookies and session cookies to make sure the website works properly and to remember your choices. The cookies described below are used when you visit our website. These cookies are necessary to provide a service you have explicitly requested – i.e. they are required for the website's functionality and to remember your choices – so we do not need your consent to place these cookies in your browser.

- To ensure the website works from a purely technical perspective, we use cookies. One cookie tracks your session by creating a random ID for your visit. Another cookie is used to improve the website's loading speed. In addition, we use cookies from our website provider Partrap and from Microsoft.
- We use cookies to protect our website from unauthorised publication of content and similar attacks by third parties. This type of cookie is necessary for the website to run reliably.
- To ensure our forms work correctly from a purely technical perspective, we use cookies from [Wufoo](#).
- To check whether you have accepted the cookies that require consent, we use cookies from Cookie-Script. Cookie-Script provides our cookie banner. The cookies used in this context ensure that we only use analytics cookies if you have given your consent in the cookie banner. This persistent cookie is required for the website's functionality, so no consent is required for its use.

Avoid cookies

You can block certain types of cookies by changing your browser settings so that it automatically refuses to store cookies, or alerts you whenever a website asks to store a cookie. You can also use your browser to see which cookies are stored and delete them. See your browser's help pages for more information.
